- Please elaborate on your knowledge of this candidate's personal traits in relation to the candidate's pursuit of learning more about Scottish culture through Scottish dance training or training in playing a Scottish musical instrument.

Music/Dance Scholarship (for those applying for instruction scholarships)

- Describe the class you want to take and who is teaching it.
- What motivated you to participate in a Scottish musical/dance organization?
- When and how long have you performed with the organization and taken instruction on this instrument or have danced with this company?
- What are your musical goals, and how will taking this class help you meet those goals?
- Describe how you participate in the Wisconsin Scottish community.

HOW TO APPLY:

Application Deadline: December 1, 2022, 11:59pm.

Applications and supplementary materials (essay, letters of recommendation, course information, etc.) shall be emailed to standrewsscholarshipmke@gmail.com. If your PDF viewer stated that you will not be able to save a copy of your filled-in form, don't fear, you can. After filling in your application, press the print button and choose a PDF printer option from your selection of available printers. That will save a copy of your filled-in application that may then be emailed to SAS.

Please note:

- *A recipient of an Ian Day Education Scholarship from the St. Andrew's Society of the City of Milwaukee may only apply again for another scholarship 2 full years after the year in which the scholarship was received. (i.e. scholarship received in 2021 by a recipient who may then apply again in 2023).*
- *Individuals may receive a maximum of two scholarships from the St. Andrew's Society of the City of Milwaukee.*
